SUBJECT: Exemption for B.Sc. Liberal students taking a Major Concentration

in Music, to the regulation regarding credits outside the Faculties of

Arts and of Science

With the introduction of the B.Sc. Liberal, Science students are now exposed to a wider range of choices, one of these being the option of taking a Major Concentration in Music. This requires an exemption to the rule limiting Science students to 18 credits outside the Faculties of Arts and of Science.

Proposed New Regulation for the Undergraduate Calendar, Section 12.3.6.2:

Students in the B.Sc. Liberal Program taking a Major Concentration in Music may exceed the 18-credit limit for courses outside the Faculties of Arts and of Science, provided that all such courses are necessary to complete their program of study, up to a maximum of 36 Music credits.
